#### HOW MANY TREATMENTS WILL I NEED?

The number of treatments required for optimal results depends on the size, location, depth and colour of the tattoo. Treatment should be performed 8-12 weeks apart in order to allow the body to remove the maximum amount of tattoo pigment after each treatment. Each session usually takes 10-20 minutes. You will continue to see lightening of your tattoo after each treatment as your body disposes of more pigment. Most patients will see improvement in their tattoos and results can be dramatic.

#### HOW WILL MY SKIN LOOK AFTER TREATMENT?

Your skin will have a white discolouration/flake, and the area around the tattoo will become reddish and appear swollen. This is normal and will disappear slowly over time. Results take about 5 weeks after each treatment. Immediately after treatment, antibacterial ointment and gauze will be applied to the treated area to minimize infection.

#### WHAT IS THE TREATMENT LIKE?

Some patients say they feel a slight sting, like the snap of a rubber band on the skin. Many treatments do not require numbing. However, some patients feel more comfortable with a local numbing agent, such as a topical numbing cream.

### ARE THERE ANY SIDE EFFECTS?

Occasionally, a whitening of the skin may occur. However, normal skin tone should return within 6-12 months following your last treatment session. Since the ink used in tattooing can vary from tattoo to tattoo, results can heavily vary dependant on how experienced or inexperienced the tattooist was, how deep the tattoo ink is and if any scarring occurred on your original tattoo, this is normally due to the tattooist going too deep with the needling. If this is the case, once your tattoo is removed - you could be left with some raised scaring.

## TATTOO REMOVAL AFTERCARE

The tattoo removal laser treatment may create a superficial burn wound. Some patients may experience bruising or swelling. There is immediate whitening of the treated area, which usually lasts for several minutes. Many clients then develop blisters, crusts, or scabs within 8-72 hours, which may last for 1-2 weeks or more. The treated areas may be pink or pale after the scab separates. Scarring, which can be hypertrophic or even keloid, can occur but is very rare. Loss of skin pigment in the treated area can occur, and is temporary except in very rare cases. Healing is usually complete within 4 weeks, although this may vary.

Keep the are clean and dry while it is healing. Clean the area gently with soap and water and then pat the area dry. We recommend you apply Savlon antiseptic cream up to 3 times per day for the first 3 days while the area is healing and you can keep the area covered with a sterile dressing for those 3 days.

Blistering is common and is likely to occur 8 hours after your treatment. Do not be alarmed, blisters heal very well and can be part of the normal healing process. Blisters indicate your body's immune system is healing the area and beginning to remove the ink from your tattoo.

You may apply a cool compress as necessary for 24 hours after the laser treatment to help reduce discomfort and inflammation. You may take painkillers, but avoid aspirin (it can increase the risk of bruising and/or bleeding).

Exercise is generally safe after treatment, taking into account the other aftercare instructions provided.

Do not pick at any scabbing or allow the skin to become scraped, as this may result in infection and scarring. Shaving should be avoided in the treated area until completely healed

Feel free to shower 2 hours after the treatment, but take care to avoid high-pressure water hitting the treated area. Baths, hot tubs, swimming pools or any form of soaking isn't recommended until all of the blistering and scabbing are completely healed, as this may increase the risk of the treated area becoming infected.

Wear a sunblock with an SPF of 50 or higher over the area for 3 months following the treatment. Do not wear any makeup or any other cream or medication on or near the treated are unless recommended by us for 48 hours.

After a few days, the treated area may begin to itch. This is very common due to the dehydrating effect of the laser treatment. Use laser aftercare cream, after sun lotion, vitamin E ointment, aloe vera or any unscented moisturiser on the treatment area, to ease the itching and avoid scratching.

If the area looks infected (honey coloured crusting and oozing or spreading redness), if you are experience an unusual discomfort or bleeding, if any other complications develop, or if you have any questions or concerns, contact us immediately.
